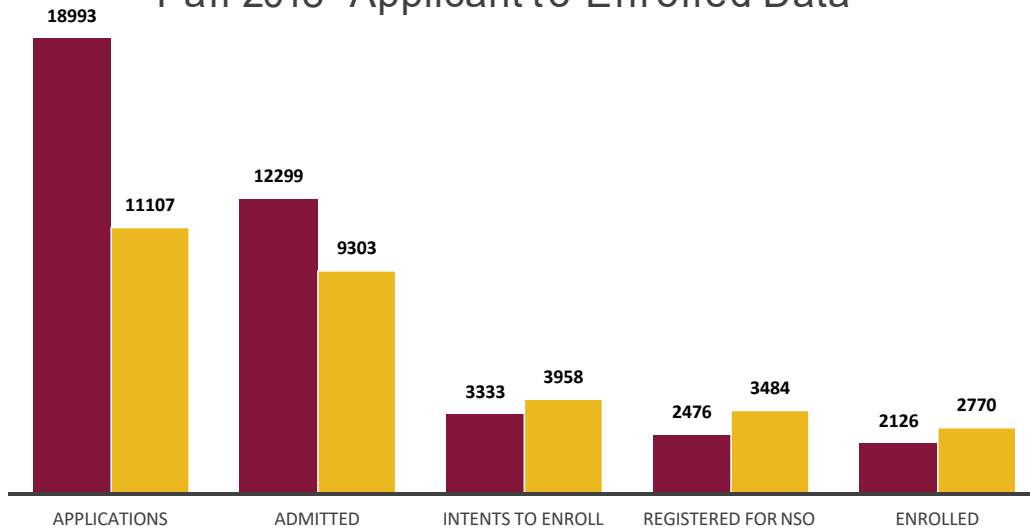

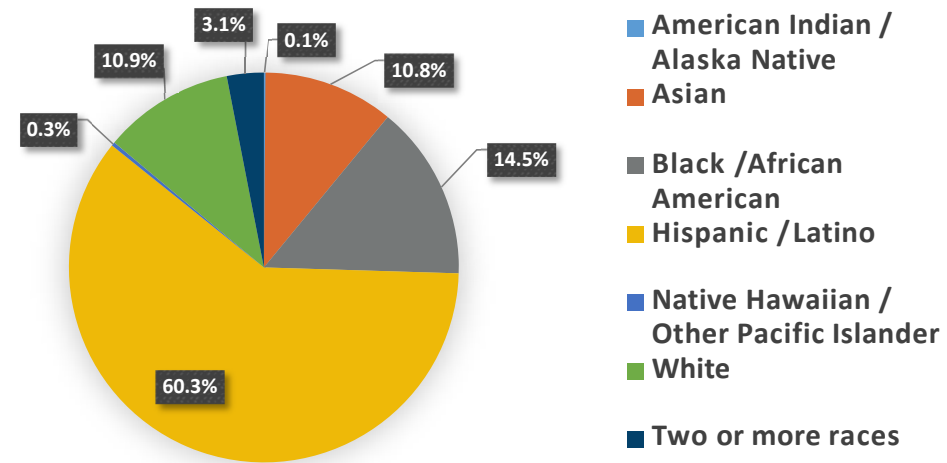
Fall 2018 - Applicant to Enrolled Data

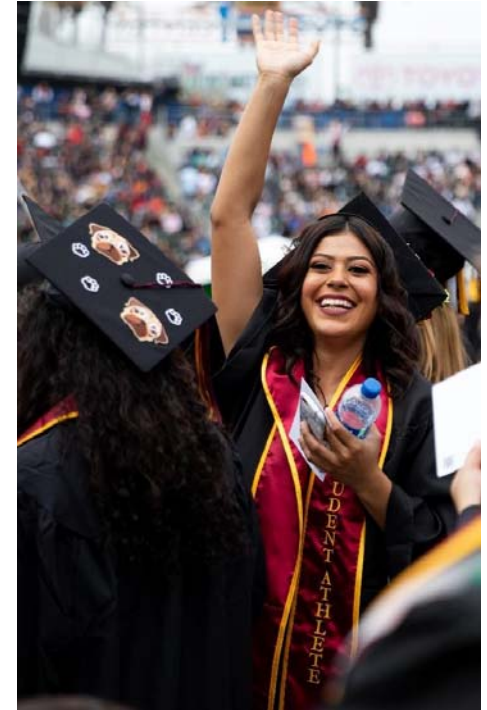

Deadline for priority Financial Aid consideration	October 1, 2018 – March 2, 2019
★ Submit \$125 Enrollment Deposit via My.CSUDH.edu	May 1, 2019
★ Register & Pay \$99 for Mandatory New Student Orientation	May 1, 2019
Deadline to submit financial aid documents	May 9, 2019
Deadline to submit Final Official Transcripts	July 15, 2019

Important Admissions Tips

- ✓ Applicants must activate their My.CSUDH portal & CSUDH email to receive communication from the University.
- ✓ CSUDH highly recommends sending Electronic Transcripts
- ✓ Review your students CAASPP reports that contain EAP results for proper course placement. *(Freshmen Only)*
- ✓ Failure to meet all admissions and enrollment deadlines will result in the cancellation of the student's admission. It is the students sole responsibility to meet all requirements and deadlines.
