OVERVIEW:

Under immediate supervision and in accordance with the provisions of the Work-Study Program of The California State University and Colleges, incumbents in this classification engage in part-time work (or full-time work during break periods) for a CSU campus or auxiliary organization.

TYPICAL ACTIVITIES:

Works part time (or full-time during break periods) in a job assignment on a CSU campus or for a CSU auxiliary organization. May be assigned work in any of the positions provided under this program by the campus or by the auxiliary organization.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Admission or registration as a student of a college or university on at least a half-time basis.
- Must meet the eligibility requirements of the Work-Study Program as determined by the campus' Financial Aid Office.
- Must have the necessary knowledges and abilities required by the campus or auxiliary organization to adequately perform the duties of the assignment.

COMPENSATION:

The specific salary rate is to be determined by each campus after consideration of appropriate and reasonable wage rates for the type of work being performed, geographical region, and proficiency of the employee, and in consideration of prevailing wage rates within the community for work assignments comparable to those for college students under the Work-Study Program.
